

It is time again to renew your Pet License(s). **All dogs and cats** must be licensed even if your pet never leaves the house. **Licenses must be renewed annually and are due before February 28, 2010. A late fee of \$5.00 per month/per animal will be assessed beginning March 1, 2010.**

3. Send/bring application to the Board of Health along with copy of current rabies certificate (inoculations must be valid through 11/1/10 – Borough Ordinances 5-1.2 and 5-2.2(f)) and proof of spaying/neutering (if not on record).
4. Please make checks payable to the Borough of New Milford.
