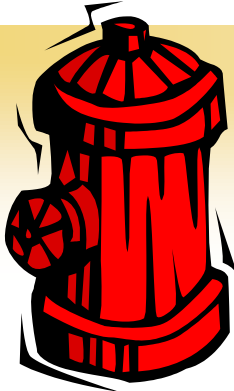


NEW MILFORD FIRE DEPARTMENT



A D O P T A H Y D R A N T

Thank you for considering to adopt a fire hydrant in the Borough of New Milford. A fire hydrant is an important part of our firefighting equipment. If your hydrant is kept clear of all obstructions, it will allow the Fire Department to do a better job without valuable loss of time. As part of your responsibilities we ask that you do the following:

- ◆ Make sure all grass and weeds are trimmed. All flowers and shrubs should be placed at least 4 feet from hydrant.
- ◆ Make sure all trash cans, rubbish and leaf piles are kept at least 4 feet from hydrant.
- ◆ If you notice a vehicle blocking your hydrant, please notify our local Police Department at 201 261-1400.
- ◆ During a snowfall please shovel at least 4 feet around all sides of your hydrant.
- ◆ Notify the Police or Fire Department if there are problems with your hydrant.

PLEASE DO NOT

- ◆ Paint your hydrant.
- ◆ Make repairs, open or remove cap from your hydrant.
- ◆ Place objects in hydrant when caps are removed.
