ORDINANCE NO. 2014:02

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER VIII OF THE
ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF NEW MILFORD
ENTITLED "PARKING AND PARKING LOTS"**

WHEREAS, the members of the Mayor and Council of the Borough of New Milford have determined the present ordinance does not adequately address the traffic safety concerns that presently affect the residents of New Milford; and

WHEREAS, The Mayor and Council of the Borough of New Milford wish to amend Chapter VIII entitled "Parking and Parking Lots" to adequately address the traffic and safety concerns that affect its residents;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of New Milford that Chapter VIII, Parking and Parking Lots, is hereby amended to as follows:

Section 8-5 is repealed and replaced in its entirety as follows:

8-5.1 Municipal Lot at Main Street and River Road (Ambulance Corps Lot).

In the lot owned by the Borough of New Milford which is north of Main Street on the east side of River Road, no person, persons, firms or corporations shall park or leave standing any vehicle, either attended or unattended except as follows:

- a. North side of the lot – Two (2) hour parking between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. every day, as duly marked. The parking of any vehicle is prohibited between the hours of 11:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.
- b. South side of the lot – Ambulance Corps personnel only, at all times, as duly marked.

- c. *Violations and Penalties.* Any person convicted of a violation of a provision of this subsection or any supplement thereto shall be liable to a penalty of fifty-seven (\$57.00) dollars for each day of occurrence.

Section 8-6 is repealed and replaced in its entirety as follows:

8-6 PARKING PROHIBITED DURING CERTAIN HOURS IN CERTAIN PARKING LOTS.

- a. The parking of any vehicle in the following parking areas is hereby prohibited between the hours of 11:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. except in those instances of persons having legitimate business to transact with the Borough or any of its agencies or departments.
 - 1. Parking lot adjacent to the Municipal Building (River Road).
 - 2. Parking lot adjacent to the New Milford Public Library (Dahlia Avenue).
 - 3. Lot owned by the Borough of New Milford which is between Cleveland Street and Fulton Street on the east side of River Road.
 - 4. Parking area adjacent to recreational facilities and the Babe Ruth field.
 - 5. Williams Field at Rambler Avenue.
 - 6. Senior Center (River Road and Milford Avenue).
- b. *Violations and Penalties.* Any person convicted of a violation of a provision of this section or any supplement thereto shall be liable to a penalty of fifty-seven (\$57.00) dollars for each day of the occurrence.

Section 8-7 is repealed and replaced in its entirety as follows:

8-7 PARKING PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES IN CERTAIN PARKING LOTS.

- a. The parking of any vehicle in the following parking areas is hereby prohibited at all times except by authorized municipal personnel.
 - 1. Fire Company #1 (Center Street and Summit Avenue)
 - 2. Fire Company #2 (Trenton Street)
- b. *Violations and Penalties.* Any person convicted of a violation of a provision of this subsection or any supplement thereto shall be liable to a penalty of fifty-seven (\$57.00) dollars for each day of occurrence.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the remainder of this ordinance remains unchanged and that this amendment shall become effective upon passage and publication in accordance with law.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that a copy of this ordinance be forwarded to the Chief of Police and the Municipal Court Administrator.
