

**ORDINANCE NO. 2014:14**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER VII OF THE REVISED GENERAL  
ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF NEW MILFORD  
ENTITLED "PARKING AND PARKING LOTS", THEREBY AMENDING  
SUBSECTION 8-5 ENTITLED "PARKING TIME LIMITED IN CERTAIN  
PARKING LOTS"**

**WHEREAS**, The Mayor and Council of the Borough of New Milford wish to amend Chapter VIII entitled "PARKING AND PARKING LOTS" to adequately address the parking and safety concerns that affect its residents;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of New Milford that Chapter VIII, Section 8-5.1, Municipal Lot at Main Street and River Road (Ambulance Corps. Lot), is hereby amended to be read as follows:

**8-5.1 Municipal Lot at 213 River Road (Ambulance Corps Lot).**

In the lot owned by the Borough of New Milford which is north of Main Street on the east side of River Road, no person, persons, firms or corporations shall park or leave standing any vehicle, either attended or unattended as follows:

- a. North & East sides of the lot – Two (2) hour between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. Monday through Saturday, as duly marked.
- b. South & East sides of the lot – Ambulance Corps personnel only, at all times, as marked.
- c. No parking or storage of any commercial vehicle for any purpose, including but not limited to temporary storage, with the exception of local delivery, pick up or patronage.
- d. No parking of vehicles awaiting or undergoing repair or awaiting retrieval by customers.
- e. *Violations and Penalties.* Any person convicted of a violation of a provision of this subsection or any supplement thereto shall be liable to a penalty of fifty-seven (\$57.00) dollars for each day of occurrence.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that the remainder of this ordinance remains unchanged and that this amendment shall become effective upon passage and publication in accordance with law.

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that a copy of this ordinance be forwarded to the Chief of Police, the Municipal Court Administrator and the New Milford Ambulance Corps.
