Councilman Colucci made a motion to approve the Fire Department appointments. Councilman Alonso seconded the motion. The motion carried. All present in favor, none opposed.

Councilman Colucci left the meeting room at 7:49 PM.

1. Approval of May 23, 2016 Closed and Work/Public Session Minutes

Council President Robalino made a motion to approve the minutes of the May 23, 2016 Closed and Work/Public Session. Councilman Cabrera seconded the motion. The motion carried. All present in favor, none opposed.

## 2. Solar Panels

Councilwoman Grant reiterated her previous comments noting that front facing and rear facing roofs should be treated equally.

Alan Silverman, Fire Chief, said the installation of solar panels is covered by the UCC (Uniform Construction Code) and the NEC (National Electric Code). He said there are no hazards associated with having the panels on a front facing roof. He shared photos of homes that have panels on front facing roofs. He said the Fire Department is notified by the Building Department whenever solar panels are installed; the Fire Department in turn notifies central dispatch and it is noted on the record for the residence in the CAD system. He said if a fire call comes in for the house the Fire Department is notified that there are solar panels on the roof. He said fires are fought differently now; they are fought from the outside and once the fire is knocked down they go inside. He said venting roofs is an old way to fight fires. He said with lightweight construction the firefighters only have 3 to 4 minutes as opposed to 18 or 19 with the heavier weight construction.

Councilman Alonso said he asked Chief Silverman to attend because since it was the Fire Department that brought this issue to the Council in 2012 because of fire safety; he said he wants to be sure that the Fire Department has no concerns for fire safety. Chief Silverman said there are no fire safety concerns with front facing panels.

3. Administrator's Report

No Report

Councilwoman Grant said she had a problem with the communication on some recent items that she wished to discuss with the Council. She said there was no notification to the public that the Memorial Day Parade was being cancelled. Mayor Subrizi said there was a reverse 911 and that she had asked the Police Department to cruise the parade route to let anyone along the route know that it was cancelled. Councilwoman Sirocchi-Hurley said the Chair of the Public Events Committee only learned of the cancellation after the decision was made; she said she would have liked to have been included in the discussion regarding the decision to cancel. Mayor Subrizi said the Grand Marshall, John DiMarchi, will be honored at the next Mayor and Council meeting on June 27<sup>th</sup>.

Councilman Colucci returned to the meeting room at 8:03 PM.

Councilwoman Grant asked why the Council was not notified officially when the schools were recently locked down. The Administrator said she received no notification of the lock-down. She said she would speak with Chief Ramaci and ask to be notified in the future so she could notify the Council.

Councilwoman Grant said the information regarding the Mayor's recent absence and her anticipated return was not as specific as she would have expected. She said she was not clear on when the Mayor returned to duty or if Council President Robalino was still acting as Mayor.

## COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC

Councilman Alonso made a motion to open the meeting for public comment. Councilwoman Grant seconded the motion. The motion carried. All present in favor, none opposed.

Frank Mattola – 1087 Lynwood Avenue. Mr. Mattola asked if the solar panel ordinances would be posted online for public review. He was advised that they would be posted the following day.

Gwen Dalton – 459 James Street. Ms. Dalton said she saw a veteran who was on the parade route waiting for the parade and a police officer drove by and did not say anything. Councilwoman Grant said we should come up with a plan to notify the public. Councilman Cabrera suggested notifying News 12.

Being no further comment from the public, Council President Robalino made a motion to close to the public. Councilman Cabrera seconded the motion. The motion carried. All present in favor, none opposed.





**WHEREAS**, in 2014, the New Jersey Division of Pension and Benefits issued a notice concerning bona fide severance of employment-post retirement employment restrictions for individuals covered by any New Jersey State administered retirement system, in order to preserve Internal Revenue Service (IRS) "qualified status" of PERS, TPAF, PFRS, SPRS and JRS plans, so as to protect retirees from a 10% excise tax penalty on their monthly retirement payments; and

**WHEREAS**, N.J.A.C. 17:1-17.14.2(a) defines a "bona fide severance from employment" as "the complete termination of the employee's employment relationship with the employer for a period of at least 180 days;" and

**WHEREAS**, if an individual returns to public employment, even as a volunteer, with the former employer prior to satisfying the requirements of a bona fide severance from employment, the employee will be required to repay all retirement benefits received from the date of retirement and may be required to re-enroll in the same or different retirement system; and

**WHEREAS**, Division of Pensions and Benefits have advised employees that they must sever all relations with their employer, including volunteer positions, for 180 days or they risk losing their pensions; and

**WHEREAS**, public employees tend to volunteer in the communities they live and work in as volunteer fire fighters, First Aid responders, celebration committee members or PTA's, to name a few; and

**WHEREAS**, for volunteer firefighters and first aid responders they would have to reapply to the volunteer organization as a new member, and, as a new member, they would be required to take all necessary test and training including physicals and agility test; and


