**PAPER SHREDDING (PS): MAY 7 and NOVEMBER 12 – 9am to 1pm, rain or shine**

### GARBAGE

SECTION **G1: TUESDAYS**

SECTION **G2: FRIDAYS**

**BOTH SECTIONS COLLECTED TUESDAYS & FRIDAYS MAY 31 TO SEPTEMBER 9.**

**Place curbside AFTER 6pm the night before collection day.**

- TRASH:** Bagged or in cans (not to exceed 40 lbs. when filled). **Up to 5 containers + 4 bags.**
- BULK ITEM:** **1 non-metal item per pick-up** (example: sofa, chair, mattress, box spring, toilet, wooden furniture).
- LATEX PAINT:** Must be in solid form. Air dry or use crystals to solidify (sold at hardware stores & DPW).
- CARPET:** Cut to 3 ft. lengths, tied & bundled (**no more than 5 bundles per pick-up**).
- WOOD:** Cut to 3 ft. lengths, tied & bundled (**no more than 5 bundles per pick-up**).
- BATTERIES:** Alkaline batteries place in trash. Only rechargeable batteries are recyclable.

### GRASS, LEAVES and VEGETATIVE GARDEN WASTE (GR)

**APRIL 6 THROUGH OCTOBER 26:** Curbside EVERY Wednesday. Place in paper bags or cans. **NO PLASTIC BAGS!**

**OCTOBER 17 THROUGH DECEMBER 30:** Rake into a neat pile at curb. Avoid covering storm water drains.

**There is NO scheduled collection day and the DPW CANNOT advise a specific pick-up day for any street.**

**RESIDENTS CAN NOW ALSO BRING THESE ITEMS TO THE RECYCLING CENTER.**

### RECYCLING

**Utilize curbside collection OR bring recyclables to the Recycling Center.**

**Curbside: Alternate Thursdays (check calendar for type of material).**

**COMINGLED (CM):** BOTTLES, GLASS, ALUMINUM, TIN, BI-METAL CANS & PLASTICS:

Place in cans. **NO PLASTIC BAGS!** Rinse/remove caps. Laminated milk containers are **NOT** recyclable.

**PAPER (P):** NEWSPAPERS, CARDBOARD, JUNK MAIL, OFFICE PAPER, ENVELOPES:

Place in paper bags, cans or tie and bundle. **NO PLASTIC BAGS!**

### SCHEDULED COLLECTIONS

**COLLECTION FOR THE FOLLOWING MUST BE SCHEDULED WITH THE DPW TWO DAYS IN ADVANCE BY CALLING 201-967-8172.**

**WHITE GOODS, SCRAP METAL, ELECTRONICS (WG):** Every 1<sup>st</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> Wednesday.

EXAMPLES: Electronics, appliances, stoves, grills (propane tank removed), refrigerators (door removed), A/Cs, TVs, lawnmowers (gas removed) and scrap metal.

**BRANCHES (BR):** Every 2<sup>nd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> Wednesday.

Curbside: Cut to 3 ft. lengths, bundle & tie or place in cans. Recycling Center: Bring unbundled.

### RECYCLING CENTER DROP OFF ONLY

**HEAVY-DUTY CARDBOARD, WASTE OIL, CAR & RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES, TEXTILES & CLOTHING.**

**TIRES:** Rims removed. NO oversized tires.

**HOLIDAY TREES (🌲):** CURBSIDE COLLECTION BEGINS JANUARY 1 TO FEBRUARY 29.

**HOUSEHOLD HAZARD WASTE (HHW):** Includes propane tanks, oil-based paint & aerosol cans. **MUST BE BROUGHT TO A BERGEN COUNTY UTILITIES AUTHORITY (BCUA) EVENT. CALL THE BCUA HHW WASTE HOTLINE: 201-807-5825 OR VISIT WWW.BCUA.ORG. CHECK THE BOROUGH WEBSITE FOR DATES.**

**CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS:** Residents are responsible for disposal. **NOT accepted as trash.**
