Dear Mr. Glozzy:

Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 58:10B-13.1 and N.J.A.C. 7:26C, the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (Department) makes a determination that no further action is necessary for the remediation of the area of concern specifically referenced above, except as noted below, so long as, United Water New Jersey did not withhold any information from the Department. This action is based upon information in the Department's case file and United Water New Jersey's final certified report dated 12/22/2008 and subsequent addendum reports. In issuing this No Further Action Determination, the Department has relied upon the certified representations and information provided to the Department.

By issuance of this No Further Action Determination, the Department acknowledges the completion of a Remedial Action and accompanying report pursuant to the Technical Requirements for Site Remediation (N.J.A.C. 7:26E) for the Entire Site. Groundwater was sampled and the results were above the GWQS (N.J.A.C. 7:9-C). The Department reserves its rights to require any person responsible for the contamination at the site to address Natural Resource Injuries.

By operation of law a Covenant Not to Sue pursuant to N.J.S.A. 58:10B-13.1 applies to this remediation. The Covenant Not to Sue is subject to any conditions and limitations contained herein. The Covenant Not to Sue remains effective only as long as the real property referenced above continues to meet the conditions of this Conditional No Further Action Letter.

No Further Action Conditions

As a condition of this No Further Action Determination pursuant to N.J.S.A. 58:10B-12o, United Water New Jersey and any other person who was liable for the cleanup and removal costs, and remains liable pursuant to the Spill Compensation and Control Act (Spill Act), shall inform the Department in writing within 14 calendar days whenever its name or address changes. Any notices submitted pursuant to this paragraph shall reference the above case numbers and shall be sent to: Bureau of Risk Management, Initial Notice and Case Assignment - Case Assignment Section, Division of Remediation Support, P.O. Box 28, Trenton, N.J. 08625.

Off-site Contamination


Please be advised that pollution in the ground water at this site exists above the Ground Water Quality Standards (N.J.A.C. 7:9-6) which may limit ground water use at this site. It has been determined that this contamination is from a source unrelated to this site.

Well Decommissioning

Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 58:4A, United Water New Jersey shall properly decommission all monitoring wells installed as part of a remediation that will no longer be used for ground water monitoring. A New Jersey licensed well driller shall decommission the wells in accordance with the requirements of N.J.A.C. 7:9D-3.1 (et seq.). After the well has been decommissioned by a New Jersey licensed well driller; the well driller is required to submit a copy of the decommissioning report on your behalf to the Bureau of Water Systems and Well Permitting. Please note that only a New Jersey licensed well driller may perform this work.
