

ORDINANCE NO. 2015:05

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER XVIII ENTITLED “EXCAVATIONS IN STREETS”, SECTION 18-1.4 AND SECTION 18-1.10, OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF NEW MILFORD.

WHEREAS, The Mayor and Council of the Borough of New Milford wish to amend Chapter XVIII, entitled “Excavations in Streets”, section 18-1.4 and section 18-1.10 of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of New Milford;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of New Milford that Section 18-1.4 of Chapter XVIII, of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of New Milford, is hereby amended to add:

d. Regulated Utilities governed by the New Jersey Board of Public Utilities pursuant to N.J.S.A. Title 48 are exempted from this section, refer to 18-1.10 Utility Road Opening, and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of New Milford that Paragraph 1 in Section 18-1.10 of Chapter XVIII, of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of New Milford, is hereby amended as follows:

All utilities regulated by New Jersey Board of Public Utilities under Title 48 which open roads in the Borough of New Milford shall pay a non-refundable application fee of \$100.00 per road opening. Said payment shall be sent to the Borough Clerk within 24 hours of completion of the utility work related to the road opening. Roadways opened by utilities shall be returned to a like new condition as set forth in 18-1.7. Infrared heat paving devices shall be used to the satisfaction of the Superintendent of Public Works (or Assistant Superintendent) or his/her designee.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the remainder of this ordinance remains unchanged and that Section 18-1.4, Chapter XVIII, of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of New Milford and Section 18-1.10, Chapter XVIII, of the Revised General Ordinances of the Borough of shall become effective upon passage and publication in accordance with law.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that a copy of this ordinance be forwarded to the New Milford Department of Public Works.
