**BOROUGH OF NEW MILFORD
ORDINANCE NO. 2013:02**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER II, ARTICLE V, SECTION 2-36 OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF BOROUGH OF NEW MILFORD ENTITLED "BEAUTIFICATION COMMITTEE".

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of New Milford wish to amend the Beautification Committee ordinance to allow for unlimited membership;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of New Milford as follows:

Chapter II, Article V, Section 2-36 shall be amended as follows:

2-36.1 Establishment; Membership

Shall be removed and replaced in its entirety as follows:

2-36.1 Establishment; Membership

- a. *Creation and Establishment of Beautification Committee.* There is hereby created and established the Borough of New Milford Beautification Committee. Membership shall be unlimited and all members shall be residents of the Borough of New Milford. All members shall be appointed by the Mayor with the advice and consent of the Council.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the remainder of this ordinance remains unchanged and all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed as to such inconsistencies only.

In the event that any word, phrase, clause, section or provision of this Ordinance is found by any Court of competent jurisdiction to be unenforceable, illegal or unconstitutional, such word, phrase, clause or provision shall be severable from the balance of this Ordinance and the remainder of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication as provided by Law.
